The Talmud invented Judaism and is the source for everything Jewish you do (and don't do) and believe (and don't believe). It is the ultimate in Jewish learning and genius. This is your opportunity to experience some “Real Talmud”: a sugya (selection) that explores the deepest ideas of the ethical and unethical uses of everyday language in human relations. This <i>sugya</i> can change your life!</p> |
| | Wednesdays 7:00–8:30 pm | <p>Speak Truth to Power: How to fix a Broken World <i>Course Description:</i> In this course we will look at stories and documents of people who courageously stood up to oppressive authority, from biblical times, through the Shoah (Holocaust) and on to the present. Students will create scenarios and tweets based on these models to help them more effectively and courageously stand up against tyranny and cruelty today. (This Wednesday elective will also continue through TRI-II.)</p> |
